ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING

The Deputy Sheriffs' Education and Training Board (DSETB) is pleased to announce the expansion of the Merit Training Program, to include an Active Shooter Course. During 2014 and 2015, the DSETB will sponsor nine (9) classes hosted by Temple University. The classes will be offered regionally throughout the Commonwealth.

This basic level course of instruction is designed to prepare the first responder to search, locate, and engage the active shooter. The course curriculum includes moving in hallways, threshold evaluation, concepts and principles of team movement, room entry techniques, pre-crises site assessment and preparation, and educating your civilian population on active shooters and a civilian response.

Below is the 2014/2015 Active Shooter Training Schedule. All course registrations are to be completed using the Deputy Sheriffs' Information System (DSIS). Registration is limited to sixteen (16) deputies. Registration is on a "first served" basis. Registrants will receive additional class information via mail, to include: required equipment, training facility locations, suggested lodging, etc. There is no registration fee. Lodging, meals, mileage, and salary will be eligible for reimbursement in accordance with the DSETB Policy. Training Expense Vouchers will be issued after the completion of each class.
