The Office of Justice Programs (OJP) of the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) announces the availability of funding under the Gun Violence Investigation & Prosecution (GVIP) Grant Program, which was established within PCCD as part of [Act 54 of 2022](#).

Under this solicitation, local law enforcement agencies and district attorneys' offices will be able to apply for a grant to investigate and prosecute:

- (1) A violation of [18 Pa. C.S. Ch. 31](#) (relating to firearms and other dangerous articles);
- (2) A crime of violence as defined in [42 Pa. C.S. § 9714\(g\)](#) (relating to sentences for second and subsequent where a firearm or a replica of a firearm, as defined in 42 Pa.C.S. § 9712(e) (relating to sentences for offenses committed with firearms), is used in the commission of the crime.

Funding can be used on improving multi-agency gun violence task forces, personnel costs, technology, and software to improve investigation or prosecutions or increase clearance rates, firearm tracing programs, and any other efforts that aid in the investigation, arrest, and prosecution of a crime involving firearms.

A total of approximately \$50 million in federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding is being announced to support this initiative. Per the requirements of Act 54, PCCD is required to prioritize funding to areas with high rates of gun violence, and reserve no less than 10% for rural communities.

**Submission Requirements for Applications:**

- **Scoring** – All applications received will be [competitively reviewed and scored](#) based on the applicant's adherence to the funding announcement guidelines and timely submission in the PCCD Egrants system.
- **Due Date** – Applications must be submitted electronically through PCCD's Egrants system no later than 11:59 PM on Thursday, October 13, 2022.
- **Technical Assistance** – Grant application and administrative guides can be accessed on [PCCD's website](#) under the Funding section. Applicants are strongly encouraged to review the application and administrative guides before calling the Egrants Help Desk for assistance. - **Egrants Submission** – An application submitted in Egrants by the deadline is not considered complete until PCCD has received the original signature page, as well as any other required documents. Successful applications will be presented for consideration at the December 14, 2022 Commission meeting.
- **Administrative Rejection** – An application that does not meet all the listed requirements in this funding announcement may be administratively rejected.
- **Corrections** – If PCCD returns an application for corrections, the final application (including all corrections and required documents) must be returned to and approved by PCCD for the requested funding to be awarded.
- **Non-supplantation** – Funding must not be used to supplant/replace state, federal, or local funds that would otherwise be available to provide for program-related services. PCCD funding is to be used in addition to other funds that are made available for services.
- **Keywords** – Applicants are required to select "Keywords" from the dropdown menu located on the Main Summary screen in Egrants.

**1. Overview:**

The Gun Violence Investigation & Prosecution (GVIP) Grant Program was established within PCCD as part of [Act 54 of 2022](#). To support the program, \$50 million in federal COVID Relief – American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was allocated through the FY22-23 state budget to support grants to local law enforcement agencies and district attorneys in Pennsylvania. Per the requirements of Act 54, PCCD is required to prioritize funding to areas with high rates of gun violence, and reserve no less than 10% for rural communities.

Law enforcement agencies and district attorneys' offices will be able to apply for a grant to investigate and prosecute:

- (1) A violation of [18 Pa. C.S. Ch. 31](#) (relating to firearms and other dangerous articles);
- (2) A crime of violence as defined in [42 Pa. C.S. § 9714\(g\)](#) (relating to sentences for second and subsequent where a firearm or a replica of a firearm, as defined in 42 Pa.C.S. § 9712(e) (relating to sentences for offenses committed with firearms), is used in the commission of the crime.

The use of funding is limited to five categories designed to allow law enforcement to improve their abilities to investigate gun crimes. Applicants may request funds for the following:

- (1) To improve and enhance coordination of Federal, State, and local law enforcement investigations and prosecutions of violations of 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 and crimes of violence involving firearms.
- (2) To support personnel costs, including salaries and overtime, relating to investigations and prosecutions of violations of 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 and crimes of violence involving firearms, with priority given to applications focusing on straw purchasers and firearms trafficking.
- (3) To purchase technology systems, including related hardware and software, to improve investigations and prosecutions or increase clearance rates, including the purchase of gunshot detection technology and other technologies that support firearm violence reduction initiatives.
- (4) Initiatives that support the tracing of firearms used to commit crimes or delinquent acts and the identification of illegal firearms traffickers.
- (5) Any other efforts that aid in the investigation, arrest, and prosecution of a crime involving firearms.

**NOTE:** PCCD currently has two other related solicitations open – the Violence Intervention & Prevention (VIP) Grant Program ([see SurveyMonkey application here](#)) and the Local Law Enforcement (LLE) Support Grant Program ([see Egrants solicitation here](#)). *The GVIP solicitation is specific to the investigation and prosecution of illegal firearm use and gun crimes.* Please see the VIP or LLE Support Grant programs for other needs.

**2. Funding Availability:**

A total of \$50 million in GVIP Grant Program funding is being announced to support this initiative, with no less than \$5 million reserved for county district attorneys' offices and law enforcement agencies serving rural communities. Please see the Eligible Applicants section for a full breakdown of eligible applicants.

For the purposes of this announcement, 'rural communities' will be those areas of the Commonwealth that have been determined in the most recent Federal decennial census as

not included within an urbanized area or urban cluster (see Appendix A for listing of eligible applicants and maximum award amount).

There is no match requirement under this solicitation. Applicants may apply for up to their maximum award (see below) over a two-year (24-month) project period.

The maximum amount of funding allowed per District Attorney’s Office and law enforcement agency is prescribed under Act 54 and determined by population:

Airport police or county park police	\$ 500,000

Please note that Act 54 provides the same the maximum allocation amounts for both the Local Law Enforcement (LLE) Support Grant Program and GVIP program. To be consistent with the LLE Support Grant Program award allocation breakdown, District Attorneys’ Offices for Philadelphia and Allegheny Counties are eligible to apply for the maximum amounts allotted for cities of the first and second class, respectively. All other District Attorney Offices will be eligible for maximum funding pursuant to their respective counties’ populations. All other law enforcement agencies may apply for the appropriate maximum allocation amount for their respective municipalities or agency type.

As noted earlier, population size as determined in the most recent Federal decennial census, as published by the Department of General Services in the most recent Pennsylvania Manual as of the effective date of this section, shall determine maximum award amounts. Regional police department caps have been determined by the population of the entire area that the regional department serves. County-based applicants should use the statutory maximum based on the county population as indicated in Appendix A. If your agency is not found in Appendix A, please email [ra-pccd-ocjsi@pa.gov](mailto:ra-pccd-ocjsi@pa.gov).

PCCD will have approval of all final budgets. After the competitive process is completed, successful applicants should expect PCCD staff to engage with them in finalizing budgets which could include the elimination or addition of budgeted items and could result in an increase or decrease to the amount requested in the grant application.

As this GVIP Program Grant solicitation is overlapping with other related solicitations (i.e., the Violence Intervention & Prevention (VIP) Grant Program and the Local Law Enforcement (LLE) Support Grant Program), PCCD staff and review teams may consider all applications collectively when determining award amounts under this solicitation. Per Act 54, priority consideration will be given to applicants in areas with high gun violence.

Award Letters will be available in Egrants, as soon as possible, after the applications are approved.

PCCD is not liable for costs incurred prior to the official start date of the award.

### **3. Project Dates:**

Contingent upon availability of funds, applications approved at the December 14, 2022 Commission meeting will be 24-month projects and have a start date of January 1, 2023 and an end date of December 31, 2024.

### **4. Eligible Applicants:**

Eligible applicants include county District Attorney's Offices and law enforcement agencies. Per Act 54, the definition of a 'law enforcement agency' is any of the following:

- (1) A public agency of a political subdivision having general police powers and charged with making arrests in connection with the enforcement of the criminal or traffic laws.
- (2) A campus police or university police department, as used in section 2416 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, certified by the Office of Attorney General as a criminal justice agency under the definition of criminal justice agency in 18 Pa.C.S. § 9102 (relating to definitions).
- (3) A railroad or street railway police department formed with officers commissioned under 22 Pa.C.S. Ch. 33 (relating to railroad and street railway police) or any prior statute providing for the commissioning.
- (4) An airport authority police department, including the Harrisburg International Airport Police.
- (5) A county park police force under section 2511(b) of the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code.

Applicants must be in good standing with PCCD to be eligible for these funds.<sup>1</sup> The applicant and recipient agencies' historical success in implementing PCCD-funded programs/initiatives that were fully implemented and met their intended goals will be considered in the review process. Applicants are not be required to have a prior funding history with PCCD to be eligible.

#### Partnerships

Applications to implement multi-organizational projects are encouraged (e.g., Gun Violence Task Forces, etc.). Applicants should provide Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) or letters of support from partnering organizations.

### **5. Program Goals, Objectives and Anticipated Impact:**

The purpose of this solicitation is to improve the investigation and prosecution of crimes committed with firearms, with the goal of reducing gun violence throughout the Commonwealth.

### **6. Eligible Program Activities and Expenses:**

Per Act 54, the use of funding is limited to five categories designed to allow law enforcement to improve their abilities to investigate gun crimes. Applicants may request funds for the following:

- (1) To improve and enhance coordination of Federal, State, and local law enforcement investigations and prosecutions of violations of 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 and crimes of violence involving firearms.

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<sup>1</sup> This may include, but is not limited to, compliance with PCCD program and fiscal reporting requirements, State and Federal funding guidelines, and acceptable risk rating as determined by PCCD.

- (2) To support personnel costs, including salaries and overtime, relating to investigations and prosecutions of violations of 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 and crimes of violence involving firearms, with priority given to applications focusing on straw purchasers and firearms trafficking.
- (3) To purchase technology systems, including related hardware and software, to improve investigations and prosecutions or increase clearance rates, including the purchase of gunshot detection technology and other technologies that support firearm violence reduction initiatives.
- (4) Initiatives that support the tracing of firearms used to commit crimes or delinquent acts and the identification of illegal firearms traffickers.
- (5) Any other efforts that aid in the investigation, arrest, and prosecution of a crime involving firearms.

All expenses must be described in the Justification box located in the Egrants Budget Detail section. PCCD has final approval of all budgets.

Additionally, as contained in Act 22 of 2017, PCCD is authorized to condition funding or grants related to the implementation, use, maintenance, or storage of Body Worn Cameras (BWCs) or recordings from BWCs. All BWC initiatives awarded will be conditioned upon protocols, guidelines, or written policies being substantially compliant with applicable recommendations of the Commission.

## **7. Required Egrants Sections/Documents:**

- a. Required Egrants Sections – All sections identified in Egrants are required. Applicants will not be able to submit their grant application in Egrants until all sections are marked as complete.
- b. Required Signed Documents – A successful application must be accompanied by the following:
  - The executed Signature Page (page 2 of the application) – see the Submission Information section of this funding announcement.
  - Letter(s) of Commitment to participate from any entity that will work with you, partner with you, or be involved in the project you propose.

## **8. Scoring:**

Applicants must submit the requested information for each section specified below within the defined response fields provided in Egrants. Responses should not be duplicated in multiple sections.

**NOTE:** Per Act 54, PCCD shall prioritize applications for areas of this Commonwealth experiencing high rates of gun violence. Applications from rural areas will also receive consideration due to the 10% reserve in available funding for those areas. In addition to reviewers scores, other factors that may be considered include geographic diversity, other applications received for similar activities in the region through the VIP and LLE Grant Programs, the applicant's compliance history with fiscal and program reporting, their historical success in implementing PCCD-funded programs/initiatives that met their intended goals, and available funding.



The following application sections in Egrants have a point value associated with them and will be scored as described below:

**a. Executive Summary** – (Maximum 5 points; length is limited to 5,000 characters; approximately one printed page)

All applicants must fill out the following script and paste into the executive summary section:

The name of applicant is requesting \$\_\_\_\_\_ to [provide a single sentence or two of what you are seeking to implement with your grant funding].

These funds will be used for the following: [provide bullet points of what the funds will be used for].

Please note that responses in this section may be used in PCCD grant summaries or be posted publicly. Plain language that clearly describes the intent of the project is most effective.

**b. Statement of Problem** – (Maximum 30 points; length is limited to 15,000 characters; approximately three printed pages)

This section establishes the locally identified gun violence problem the applicant is seeking to address and how the problem was identified.

Provide supporting data/facts/figures specific to the project and relevant to the gun violence investigation and/or prosecution problem and request. Include data specific to the geographic area the project will serve and compare this data to other available state, local, and/or national data elements to articulate the need.

Applicants are also asked to express why GVIP funding is needed to support the proposed project. Applicants are strongly encouraged to describe their financial need, or the financial need of their community, as part of the response in this section to justify why funding is needed to support the project. This may include information regarding the impact to the applicant agency, agency operations, or the community if grant funds are not procured.

**c. Category Activities** – (Not Scored; Checklist only)

This section is a non-scored checklist included in the Egrants application process. Applicants are required to select one or more of the five categories of eligible items or activities included in Act 54 that directly relate to their application. Applicants should determine which eligible category(ies) best fits their project.

**d. Project Description** – (Maximum 35 points)

This section establishes that the applicant has reviewed the eligible categories for funding and has established a plan for project implementation that addresses the overarching goal of this solicitation (i.e., to improve gun violence investigation and prosecution with the ultimate result of reducing gun violence in a particular area of the Commonwealth). Applicants shall be required to fill out the appropriate Category

sections that align with their proposal.<sup>2</sup> Applicants are asked to provide the following information per Category:

**Category 1: Improve and enhance coordination of federal, state and local law enforcement:**

- Whether the applicant currently has a coordinated gun violence task force, and who is included on the task force.
- If the applicant is planning to improve coordination or establish a task force, who is the applicant planning to include in the applicant's task force or coordinated group (e.g., state level investigators, federal investigators, other local LE agencies)?
- Description of the work that will be accomplished during the project period.
- Description of how the coordinated effort will help to reduce gun violence in your jurisdiction.
- Plans for subcontracting any part of the project, including the role to be performed by each subcontractor (if applicable).
- Letters of support from the agencies that the applicant plans to partner with.

**Category 2: Support Personnel Costs:**

- Number of sworn officers/detectives currently employed who work on gun violence investigations.
- Description of the need for additional funding to either hire additional officers, or support overtime for existing officers.
- Description of how the additional funding for personnel will decrease gun violence in your jurisdiction.

**Category 3: Technology systems to support firearm violence reduction initiatives:**

- If the applicant currently has gunshot detection technology, what type of technology do they use and how do you use it?
- The type and cost of the technology that the applicant intends to purchase, how it works, and a description of what it is meant to do.
- Description of how the technology will decrease gun violence in your jurisdiction.

**Category 4: Initiatives to support tracing firearms:**

- Whether the applicant currently has any initiatives in place to support tracing firearms and what they are.
- The type and cost of the initiative(s) the applicant intends to put into place to support firearms tracing if awarded this funding.
- Description of the work that will be accomplished during the project period.
- Description of how the project will decrease gun violence in your jurisdiction.
- Letters of support from any stakeholders involved in the tracing initiatives.

**Category 5: Other efforts to aid in investigation, arrest, and prosecution of crime involving firearms:**

- Detailed description of the type of program or effort that will be made to aid in these investigations.
- Description of why this approach will work to improve investigation, arrest, and prosecution of gun crimes.

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<sup>2</sup> **NOTE:** Applicants do not need to fill out Category sections that do not pertain to their project proposal. However, to navigate Egrants, sections that are NOT filled out must be marked by the applicant as "Complete" in order to submit the application.

- Description of how the project will decrease gun violence in your jurisdiction.
- Letters of support from any stakeholders involved in the proposed initiative(s).

**e. Performance Measures/Impact/Outcomes** – (Maximum 15 points)

This section requires applicants to describe the data the applicant will collect and provide to PCCD to measure the impact of their project on their jurisdiction.

At a minimum, applicants will be asked to provide the following information:

- Number of full-time sworn law enforcement personnel.
- Number of part-time sworn law enforcement personnel.
- The mechanism or tool(s) that will be used to collect data for purposes of evaluating program outcomes (e.g., UCR, NIBRS, RMS data collection; pre/post testing or surveys; court records; etc.).
- How the outcomes of the proposed project will be measured (i.e., short-term and long-term outcomes, data collection, and analysis, etc.).
- Description of how the project aligns with existing best practices or programs and provide citations as applicable.
- The expected project impact.

Under this funding announcement, applicants **are required** to develop performance measures, as part of the application, that are specifically related to the proposed activities outlined in the application. Subgrant recipients under this Funding Announcement **will be required** to report outcome data to PCCD on the deliverables described in the application via Quarterly Progress Reports in PCCD’s Egrants system.

**f. Budget Detail** – (Maximum 15 points)

As stated in PCCD's Applicant's Manual, all costs must be allowable, necessary for the performance of the project, reasonable, allocated to the project consistently, and claimed against only one grant award.

The budget detail section should identify what the funds will be used for and line items should be entered for each budgeted cost. Clearly identify all costs, including salary and benefits. Calculations should be clear and entered as the Egrants system requires in the budget detail section.

For any budgeted cost that is not self-explanatory, clearly explain the relationship between the budgeted costs and the proposed project activities/operation. Describe how the item will be used in the implementation of the proposed project. This section may include additional explanation of the computations stated in the Budget Detail section; however, computations provided within the line items should not be replicated in the justification field(s).

**NOTE:** PCCD will have final approval of all budgets and may require budget reductions.

**9. Competitive Bidding/Sole Source Procurement:**

All procurement transactions shall be conducted in a manner that provides open and free competition. Grant recipients must follow the Procurement Standards section in PCCD’s [Applicant’s Manual](#).

Procurements by noncompetitive proposal are strongly discouraged and must demonstrate an economic benefit or lack of alternate resources to be justified. If a request is made,

the prospective applicant must identify the request as a procurement by noncompetitive proposal and provide a substantial justification for the request **within** their funding request (**See PCCD's [Applicant's Manual for Procurement by Noncompetitive Proposal Approval Procedure](#)**).

## **10. Administrative Requirements:**

### **a. Egrants Agency and User Registration:**

Prior to submitting a grant application, both the applicant agency and at least two users from the applicant agency must be registered in Egrants. Applicants are strongly advised to allow adequate time to work on application documents in Egrants prior to the submission deadline. Please go to the [Registering in Egrants](#) on PCCD's website for further information. ### **b. Fiscal Accountability:**

### **c. Time and Effort Reporting:**

### **d. Grant Payments:**

- Payments will not be released until all applicable special conditions on the grant award have been satisfied.
- All grantees are required, at a minimum, to submit quarterly fiscal reports. PCCD will only make payments to reimburse actual expenditures reported on the fiscal reports. An agency experiencing cash flow problems may submit fiscal reports monthly and PCCD will reimburse reported expenditures. Non-submission or late submission of the required reports will result in payment delays.
- ACH Payments:
  - All payments to grant recipients will be made through ACH.
  - Either before or at the time an application is submitted to PCCD, the applicant agency must [register as a Non-Procurement Vendor](#) with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

### **e. Federal Transparency Act Certification:**

This section is required for both state and federal funding streams. See the [Federal Application Requirements page](#) on PCCD's website for further information.

### **f. Reporting Requirements:**

- Programmatic reports are due quarterly.
- Fiscal reports are due quarterly.
- Late submission of programmatic and fiscal reports may delay payments.
- All reports must be submitted through the Egrants system.

### **g. UCR Reporting:**

Every criminal justice entity who is required to submit UCR report data and is participating in this project must submit Uniform Crime Report (UCR) data to the Pennsylvania State Police. If a required entity is not submitting UCR data, they may be ineligible for funding.

### **h. Information Technology (IT) Project Conditions:**

PCCD is required to include subgrant conditions for grants that will fund IT projects. These conditions are mandated to ensure compatibility with state and federal IT standards and requirements. View these [IT Conditions](#) on PCCD's website.
